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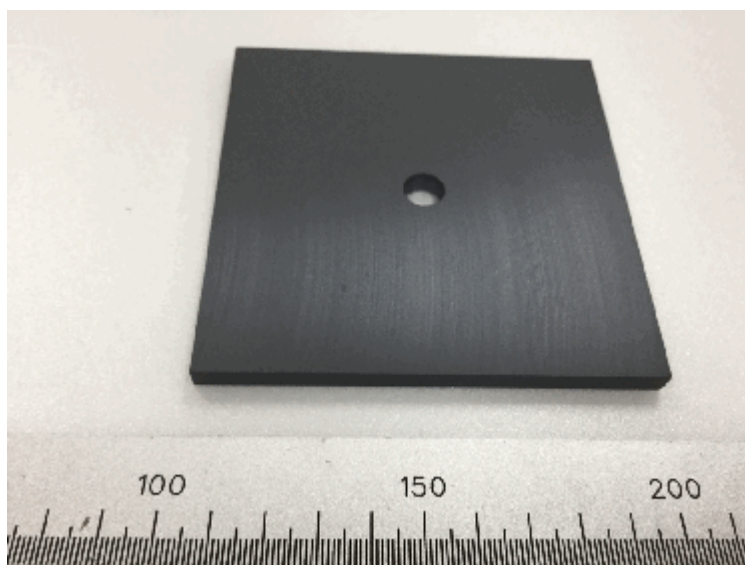

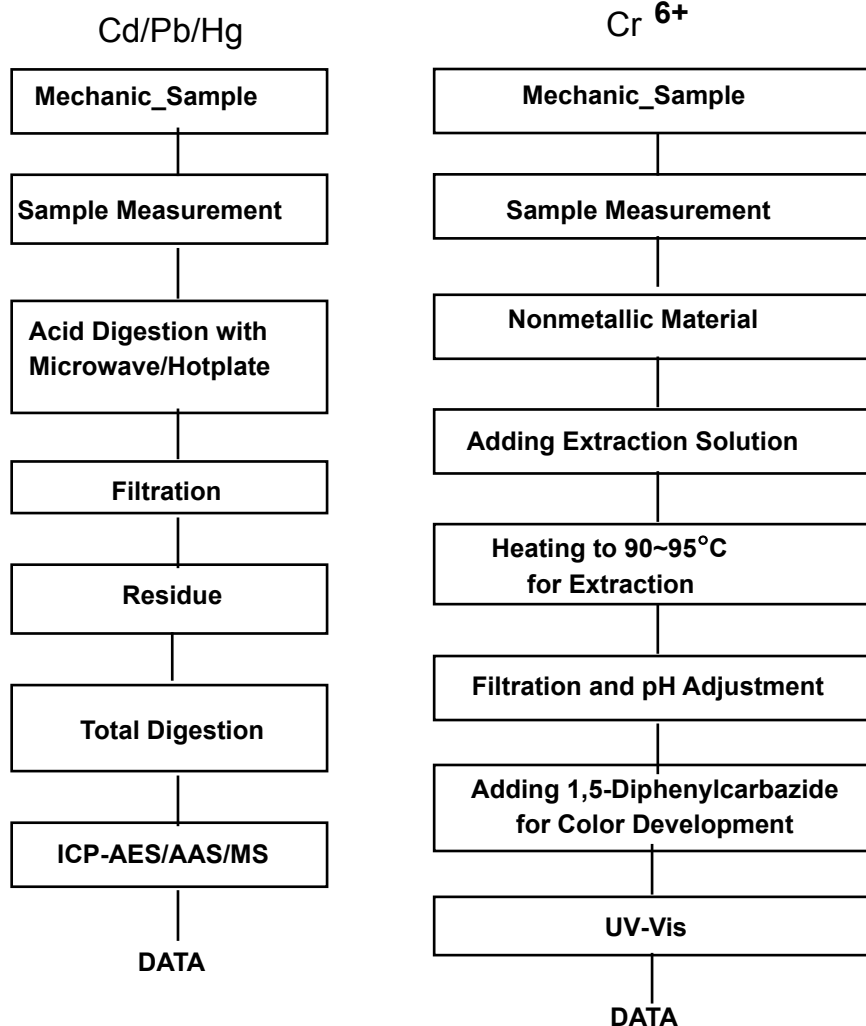

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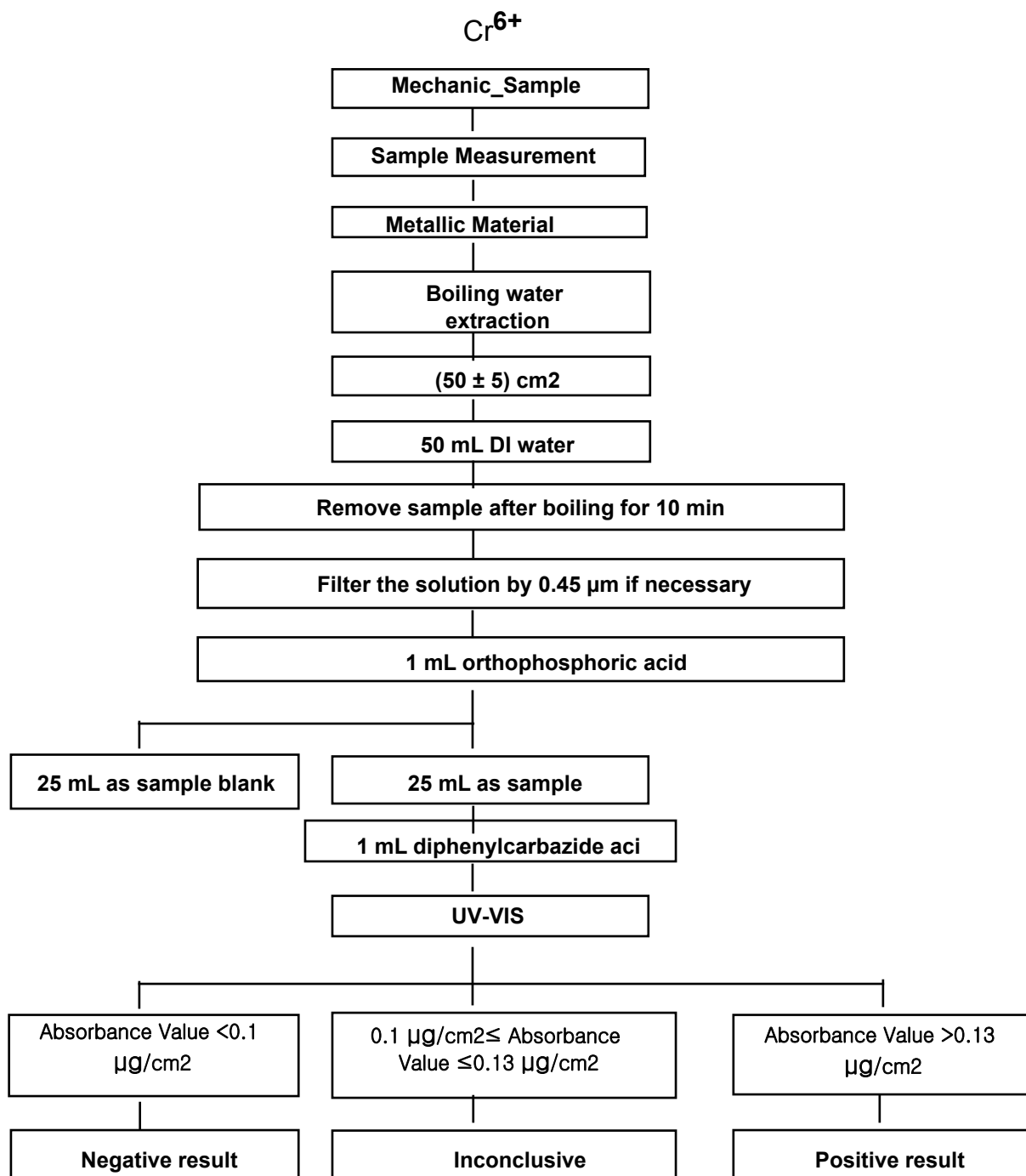


Testing Flow Chart for RoHS:Cd/Pb/Hg/Cr⁶⁺ Testing

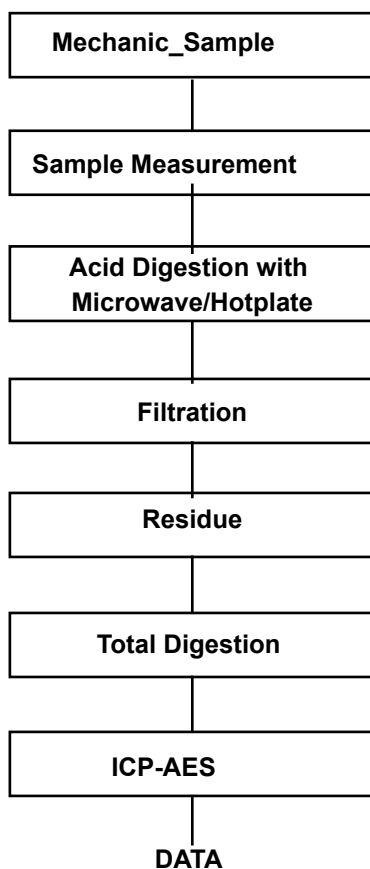


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Flow Chart for Inorganic Elements Testing

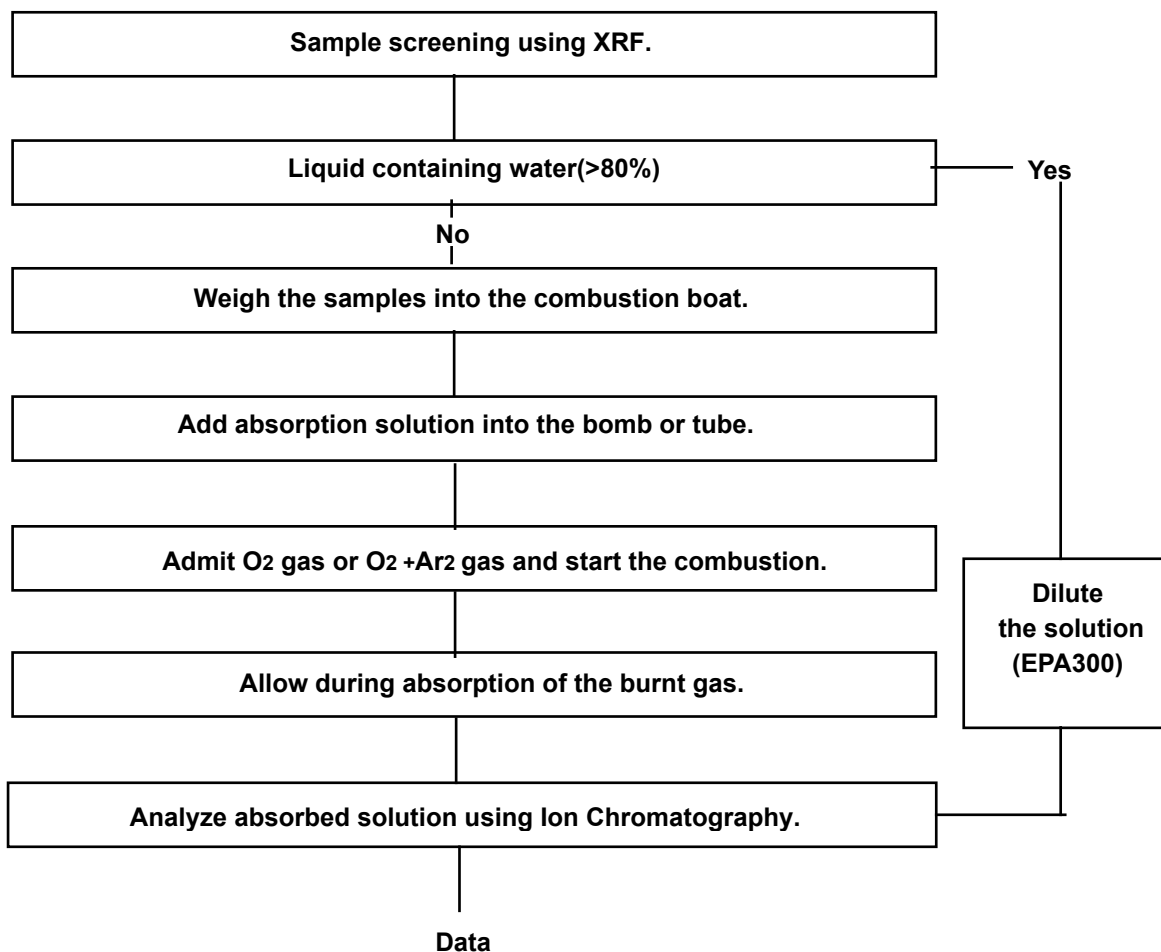

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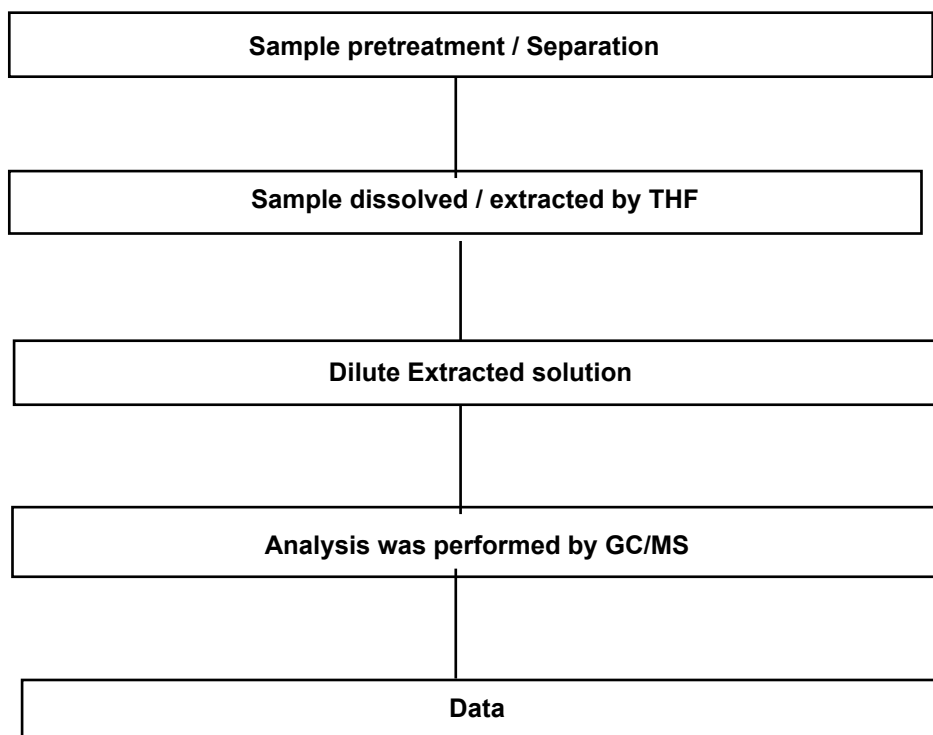
Flow Chart for Halogen Test
